

PLANE is a seven-year, £95m programme funded by the UK Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO), implemented by DAI Global UK (DAI), and agency procurement services from Crown Agents.

The programme represents one window of intervention in a broader package of investment, intended to enable a more inclusive and effective basic education system in Nigeria. This will improve learning outcomes for students in their pre-primary and primary years. It seeks to do this through improvements in teaching and learning, focusing on foundational skills, unlocking governance bottlenecks for better education service delivery, improvements in the regulation of the non-state sector, and embedding the use of data and evidence within the education system.

Working in Kano, Kaduna, Jigawa States, and the Federal Capital, PLANE supports government partners at all levels to achieve the aim of reaching 1.5 million learners.

- The storage, destuffing, picking, repacking, labelling and re-boxing of pupils' books, teacher's guides and posters for onward shipment.
- Third Party Logistics (3PL) services for the distribution of the repacked and labelled materials to the selected schools in Local Government Areas (LGAs) of the three project states.
